



ED SWEENEY MEMORIAL RESEARCH GRANTS

Beginning in 2015, and annually thereafter, Ed Sweeney Memorial Research Grants will be awarded to individuals or groups who plan to prepare a publication or production that promises to contribute significantly to awareness of Manitoba's hockey history. The publication or production may be a book, an article, a film, a television program, a radio program, a theatrical production, an internet production, or a public exhibition. Researchers will be required to fill out an application form that can be found on the website of the Manitoba Hockey Hall of Fame (www.mbhockeyhalloffame.ca).

The maximum amount that will be allocated for grants in any one year is \$10,000.00, and the maximum amount that will be awarded to any one project is \$5000.00. The deadline for the applications for the 2016 grants is December 31, 2016. Applications will be judged by a selection committee whose recommendations must be ratified before announcements are made.

The recipients of the Sweeney Research Grants for 2016 will be announced in May 2017.

Note to applicants: These grants are designed to support research on the history of hockey in Manitoba. Our expectation is that the research will result in a book, an article, a film, a television program, a radio program, a theatrical production, an internet production, or a public exhibition. Another expectation is that when the publication or production appears, suitable credit for financial assistance will be given to the Manitoba Hockey Hall of Fame. By January 1 of each year, award winners will be expected to produce for the Hockey Hall of Fame a progress report on the research. Unsuccessful applications can be re-submitted the next year, with or without changes.

Detailed budget for anticipated research: (Eligible expenses include economy return air fares, return mileage expenses at .20 cents per kilometer each way, expenses for meals while travelling up to \$35.00 per day, accommodation costs up to \$125.00 per day, photocopying costs, minimum wage costs for translators or research assistants, and other costs deemed reasonable by the Manitoba Hockey Hall of Fame.) Receipts for expenses must be provided if requested. This grant cannot be used for wages for the primary researcher(s). The maximum amount that will be allocated for each project is \$5000.00.
